Next half term, we will be exploring the continent of North America! To get ready for our exciting unit, we'd like you to complete one of the following projects for your half-term homework. Choose the one (or more) that interests you the most:

- Create a Map: Make a colourful map of North America. Include major rivers, mountains, cities, and national parks. Use symbols and a key to show different features!
- Country Research Poster: Choose a country in North America, like Canada, the USA, or Mexico. Create a poster with information like the country's flag, capital city, major landmarks, and interesting geographical features.
- Explore Climate Zones: Research the different climate zones in North America. Create a presentation or a poster to show what each zone is like, including temperatures, types of plants, and animals that live there.
- Build a Landform junk model: Pick a landform, like the Rocky Mountains or the Great Lakes, and create a 3D model. Make sure to add labels and facts about what makes your landform special!
- Discover Cultural Geography: Choose a region in North America to research. Find out about its geographical features and how they influence local culture, like food and music. Present your findings in a poster or presentation.
- Keep a Geography Journal: For one week, write in a journal about your local geography and compare it to a specific area in North America. Include drawings and photos to make it special!
